

The challenge:

Spanish teachers want to keep things simple. Dealing with cumbersome technology or constantly asking the IT department for help is an annoying extra effort, and often does not produce the expected outcome in a timely way. Things are even worse when adopting a new platform: integration with the current system, training everyone, overcoming problems and glitches...

And once the district has adopted that awesome textbook program from a publisher, why should teachers be forced to use the program in just one particular way? Teachers want to be in control, building their classes, including their own time-tested materials, and getting meaningful feedback with a simple dashboard so it's easy to know what's going on at glance—not juggling ten different tools in one class period. And grading? How can grading be meaningful for the student but not take ages for the teacher?

The solution:

To solve this, we built Wicco. With Wicco, schools can access all of their textbook materials, relying on the flexibility of a Common Cartridge in their LMS of choice. But it's not just about the Common Cartridge; it's about the content. Wicco is able to manage all elements while preserving the properties of each: each interaction, tracking, grades, configuration, etc. Scorms and xAPI items are transparent, because teachers can see their context, content, grades, and attempts. In a single place, teachers can both customize an activity's settings and see class results. Additionally, by incorporating the content as small packages, teachers can easily select what to use in class and discard any unwanted elements.

Wicco combines all the power of the LMS, the flexibility of Common Cartridge, and the intelligence of the data. But our solution takes it one step further: with our program, we add much more: assessments in the native environment of the LMS, and a question bank with more than 3,000 activities, allowing teachers to edit assessments within a familiar platform. So no more assessment generators that are disconnected from the rest of the class materials.

Learning Impact Outcomes:

Instruction can be tailored on a continual basis, making the class more responsive to students' needs. Moreover, the feedback can guide teachers on a whole-class basis ("Let's review that reading selection again; I see that it gave everyone difficulty."), as well as help differentiate instruction for individual students ("I'm going to give Susie some additional practice resources; I see she is struggling with this concept."). In this way, instruction can be constantly adjusted, helping students achieve and retain knowledge and skills.
